Earl M. Akers, 93, Crystal Spring, died Tuesday, July 18, 1989 at the Newton D. Baker Veterans Administration Medical Center, Martinsburg, WV.

He was born January 25, 1896 in Silver Mills, Bedford County, a son of the late James N. and Evelene (Kennard) Akers. He married Maude (Spade) Hendershot in Cumberland, MD on January 20, 1927.

Funeral services were held Friday, July 21, 1989 at 2:00 p.m. in the Dalla Valle Funeral Chapel. The Rev. Ralph Wilson officiated. Burial was made in McKendree Cemetery with full military graveside honors conducted by the Everett Honor Guard, also acting as pallbearers.
