

MRS. ELIZABETH ALEXANDER

Mrs. Elizabeth Alexander, widow of the late Linn Alexander of McConnellsburg died at the home of Charles Truax, E. Lincoln Way here on Friday, January 2, 1942. Death was attributed to influenza which lasted for one week.

The deceased was a daughter of the late Jacob and Lucinda Clevenger and was born November 21, 1874, hence was aged 67 years, 1 month and 11 days at the time of death. Her husband, Linn Alexander preceded her in death two years ago.

One daughter, Mrs. Benjamin Butterbaugh survives, also a niece and nephew who were reared by Mrs. Alexander, Merrill Seville and Ruth Seville, wife of Charles Truax. Three sisters and one brother survive: Mrs. Daisy Seiders and Mrs. Minerva Walker, both of McConnellsburg; Mrs. Ella Kuhn of Franklin county and Lewis Clevenger of Mercersburg.

Mrs. Alexander was a member of the local Lutheran church. Funeral services were held at the White church south of McConnellsburg on Sunday, January 4 at 2:30 P. M., with Rev. J. M. Pheasant officiating. Interment was made in the adjoining cemetery.
