

Dr. J. Frank Alexander

A retired dentist and community leader, Dr. J. Frank Alexander, 75, McConnellsburg, died at approximately noontime Thursday, November 22, 1990 at the Fulton County Medical Center.

Born July 1, 1915 in McConnellsburg, he was the son of the late Robert G. and Laura (Henry) Alexander. He was married to the former Doris McKenzie.

Surviving are his wife, at their home; a son, William R. Alexander, Huntingdon and two grandsons.

Dr. Alexander was a member of St. Paul's United Church of Christ, McConnellsburg. He was also a member of George Washington Lodge No. 143, Free and Accepted Masons, Chambersburg; a life member of McConnellsburg Volunteer Fire Company and president emeritus of the Board of Directors of the Fulton County National Bank.

A graduate of Juniata College, Class of 1938 and the University of Pittsburgh Dental School in 1943, he had practiced dentistry in McConnellsburg from 1945 until his retirement in 1975. He was a veteran of World War II, having served as a captain in the U.S. Army Dental Corps.

Funeral services were held at 2:00 p.m. Saturday, November 24, at the Kelso/Cornelius Funeral Home. The Rev. Barron Barley officiated. Burial was made in Union Cemetery.
