

MARY A. ALEXANDER.

Mary Ann Alexander aged 2 years, 9 months, and 10 days, daughter of Clinton and Maria Dickson Alexander of Washington, D. C. died at the Episcopal Eye, Ear and Throat hospital in that city, Saturday morning, February 15, 1919. The child's remains, accompanied by the parents, arrived in McConnellsburg Sunday evening and the funeral took place from the home of the mother's aunties, Misses Annie and Minnie Dickson, East Lincoln Way, Monday afternoon. The services were conducted by Rev. J. L. Grove, and interment was made in the cemetery at the Presbyterian church.

Mary Ann was the very picture of health until attacked by measles a few weeks ago and this led to mastoids and other complications. The child was placed in one of the best hospitals and had the attention the most skilful surgeons; but the Master had need of her and called her to a place in that home of many mansions there to await the coming of the grief stricken parents left behind.
