Mrs. Lydia Aller

Mrs. Lydia Aller, 93, one of Fulton county's few nono genarians succumbed to infirmities of age on Saturday, March 5, 1960 at the Fulton County Medical Center, She had been a patient there for about twenty four hours. Mrs. Aller made her home with Mrs. Mary Baker, near Knobsville.

- Had "aunt Lydia" as she was familiarly known to many, lived until April 22, of this year she would have attained her 94th birthday, just six years from the hundredth year. Many felt that her constitution was strong enough to possibly see her attain her 100th birthday, but the will of the heavenly one saw fit to call her home.

The deceased was born at Knobsville, Todd township, this county on April 22nd, 1867, the last one of seven children, born to Francis,

and Sarah Ann (Tice) Hershey. On January 4, 1887, she married James A. Aller who preceeded her in death 33 years ago on March 14, 1927. The couple made their home together at Knobsville where they farmed modestly and reared a large family. She was a life long mem ber of the Knobsville Methodist church.

Mrs. Aller's life was not always one of good fortune in many ways because in 1948 when she was 81 years young she was hospitalized for some time as a result of a Copperhead snake bites. two places on her left hand. she suffered much agony un til finally overcoming the bad effects and three years later she fractured her left arm in a fall and several years later she suffered a fractured hip that hospitalized her for several months. A strong constitution and a faith unsurpassed pulled Aunt Lydia through along with good care she received from members of her familv.

Her family is comprised of the following survivors: Harry Aller of Kansas, Nevin Aller of Altoona. Mrs. Mae Efer of Akron, Ohio. Mrs. Bruce Hetrick of Huntingdon, Brice Aller of Need more., Oscar Aller of Harris burg, Mrs. Bessie Rooney of Detroit, Mich., and Mrs. Alma Ramsey of Altoona.
