Warren "Guy" Anderson, 81, Needmore, died Wednesday, February 26, 2014, at Harrisburg General Hospital.

Born July 19, 1932, at his grandparents' home located in Eagles Foundry near Broad Top, he was the son of the late W. Lee and Lottie L. (Griffith) Anderson.

As a very young boy, he lived with his family in Todd where he attended the Green School in Trough Creek Valley. Later his family purchased a dairy farm located on Enid Road near Wells Valley where he attended the Rock Run School.

He was a farmer at heart and after leaving the family farm, he worked as a dairy herdsman at Wayne Locke's farm near Lemasters and Foster Swope's farm near Needmore. Through the years, he also worked at Gateway and Texaco in Breezewood, Maynard Wilkins Feed Mill in Crystal Springs, and drove a coal truck for Orin Shaw.

Most Fulton County folks may remember Guy best from his 54 years as a partner in the A&G Lumber Co., with his dear friend, Blaine Gordon of Needmore. He also enjoyed many years of hunting and storytelling with Blaine and many of his other friends of the Needmore-based "Gordon Gang."

During the past 31 years, he operated a 1,500 capacity pig farm, after working a full day in the woods, to nurture his love for farming. He loved horses and Jack Russell dogs.
