Ambrose Norris Apple, Sr., 86, Warfordsburg and formerly of Cumberland, MD, died Wednesday, March 24, 1999 at Sacred Heart Hospital in Cumberland.

Born February 5, 1912 in Romney, WV, he was the son of the late Walter and Eunice (Norris) Apple.

He retired in 1989 from the Maryland State Highway Administration as an inspector after 33½ years of service. He was formerly employed with Celenese in Cumberland for 18 years. He had been a meat cutter for Harry Souders and had worked for Andy Cohill Orchards, formerly of Hancock and Baker Waverly Survey Co.

He was of the Protestant faith and a member of The American Humane Society and a member of National Federation of Wildlife and a member of the National Audubon Society and a member of the MCEA.

He is survived by his wife, Margaret E. (Powell) Apple of Warfordsburg, whom he married February 25, 1935 in Berkeley Springs; two daughters: Eudora Cowan of Cumberland; Norma DeWitt of Lake, MI and one son, Ambrose Norris Apple, Jr., Metamora, MI; nine grandchildren; nine great-grandchildren and a great-great-grandchild.

He was a 1932 graduate of Hancock High School.

He was also preceded in death by two sisters: Lillian Marvin and Eudora Brown; three brothers: Dwars Apple, Jessie Apple and George Apple.
