Rev. Clinton K. "Clint" Bahrenburg, 57, of Lehman Road, Warfordsburg, Pa., died Tuesday, June 29, 2004, at Morgan County War Memorial Hospital in Berkeley Springs, W. Va.

Born April 10, 1947, in Oceanside, N.Y., he was the son of Maude Frances Waldman Bahrenburg of Warfordsburg and the late Richard Bahrenburg Jr.

He was pastor of Buck Valley Christian Church since June 20, 1981.

He was a graduate of State University of New York at Stony Brook, where he received a B.A. in social work. He received a Master of Divinity degree from Westminster Theological Seminary at Philadelphia. He was ordained April 13, 1986.

His credentials were held by Conservative Congregational Christian Conference. He was associate pastor for one year in Ambler, Pa., after graduating from seminary in 1979. He was a member of the board of trustees of Joy-El Ministries, a member of the Hancock Council of Churches, Bedford County Ministerium, the Ministerial Fellowship of Hollidaysburg, the Ministry Committee Conservative Congregational Christian Conference, and he was the pastor-in-residence for Warfordsburg Senior Center.

Besides his mother, he is survived by his wife, Debbie H. Harclerode Bahrenburg, whom he married July 18, 1987; one sister, Janese Bahrenburg of Avon Park, Fla.; four brothers: Richard and Bradley, both of Long Island, N.Y.; Russell and Frederick, both of Boca Raton, Fla.; and 14 nieces and nephews.

Services were held Friday, July 2, 2004, at 11:00 a.m. at Buck Valley Christian Church, with Rev. Greg Hughes, Rev. Richard Lang and Rev. Robert Steinke officiating. Burial
