

**Walter A. Bair**

Walter A. Bair, 88, Warfordsburg, died Wednesday, November 16, 1995 at Washington County Hospital.

Born June 12, 1907 near Hancock, he was the son of the late Jerry A. and Ella Nora Truxell Bair.

He was a 1926 graduate of Hancock High School and a 1928 graduate of Bliss Electrical School, Tacoma Park, MD.

He was a self-employed electrical contractor, working in Washington, D.C.

He served on the Southern Fulton School Board; the Fulton County Planning Commission and was active in various public service commissions.
