Calvin Baker, died at his home on Clear Ridge Wednesday, May 3, 1922, at the age of 74 years, 5 months and 29 days. Burial at Clear Ridge Saturday, the 6th inst at 2 p. m., Rev. W. M. Cline of Ft. Littleton assisted by Rev. Gardner of Hustontown conducting the funeral services in the Clear Ridge M. E. Church.
