Mrs. Deborah, wife of Elijah Baldwin, died at Fort Littleton, Monday evening of last week. Mrs. Baldwin was in usual health up to last Friday evening when she was stricken with paralysis. Besides her husband she is survived by one son, and two daughters, John, at Burnt Cabins; Rebecca, wife of Elmer Fraker, and Kate, wife of Ellis Fraker, both of Fort Littleton.

The funeral of Mrs. Deborah Baldwin was conducted at her late residence in Fort Littleton, Wednesday afternoon at one o'clock, by J. Vernon Adams, pastor of the Methodist Episcopal church, assisted by the Rev. Wesley Cline. The deceased was aged 68 years, 9 months, and 1 day. She was a lady who, in her earlier years, cultivated the beautiful grace of ministry among the sick, which work she delighted in until the day when she was herself compelled to succumb to weakness.

In her declining years she was characterized by a devotion to the Holy Bible and it was no uncommon thing for those who knew her best to notice her delight in the truths it contains. Mrs. Baldwin is universally missed among the circle in which she moved.
