

**Stanley J. Barber**

Stanley James Barber, 62, RR 1, Needmore, school bus driver with the Southern Fulton School District, died Sunday, January 3, 1982, in the Newton D. Baker VA Center, Martinsburg, W. Va.

Mr. Barber was born April 9, 1919, in Arena, N.Y., son of the late Frank and Sarah Yeomans Barber. He was retired from the U.S. Air Force and for the past 10 years was employed as a bus driver.

He was a member and officer of the Needmore Volunteer Fire Company, having been named firefighter of the year in 1979, and served as Fulton County radio coordinator for Civil Defense.
