Funeral services were held on Monday afternoon, November 25, 1963, at the Bethlehem EUB Church near McConnellsburg, for Arnold Paul Bard of McConnellsburg, RD, who died on Friday, November 22, at 7:20 P. M., at the Chambersburg Hospital, following a long illness.

Born at Sipes Mill, Fulton county, on December 13, 1909, he was a son of Newton J. and Tena Strait

Bard. He was superintendent of the Bethlehem EUB Sunday School for many years, and had been employed at Letterkenny Army Depot for twelve years.

Surviving, in addition to his parents, are his wife, Julia Batdorff Bard; two daughters: Mrs. Gilbert Deshong of McConnellsburg and Mrs. John D. Grillone of Hawaii, and one granddaughter.
