Frank Earnest Bard, 73, Warfordsburg, died at 8:15 p.m. Tuesday, June 27, 1995 in the Milton S. Hershey Medical Center.

Born April 8, 1922 in Pleasant Ridge, Fulton County, he was a son of the late Oliver and Nettie Mellott Bard.

A member of Jerusalem Christian Church, Warfordsburg, he was a deacon, Sunday School superintendent and Sunday School teacher, all for more than forty years.

For thirty years, he was president of Bedford-Fulton County Christian Conference and a 25-year officer of the Agricultural Stabilization and conservation Service in Fulton County.

He was a retired dairy farmer.
