Mary K. Bard, 91, a resident of Menno Haven Nursing Home and formerly of McConnellsburg, died Wednesday, September 20, 1999 at the home.

Born January 2, 1908 in McConnellsburg, she was the daughter of the late Daniel and Sarah Knauff. She was preceded in death by her husband, Lynn S. Bard in 1995.

She worked as a teacher and librarian in the Irvington High School in Irvington, NJ from 1938-1970.
