

## THOMAS WILSON BARD

Mr. Thomas Wilson Bard, 61, a resident of Hustontown, Pa., died suddenly on September 26, 1945 at his home there of a heart condition. Mr. Bard's death came as a great shock to his family and friends.

The deceased was a son of the late George W. and Rebecca Rodgers Bard and was born on July 12, 1876 at Orbisonia, Huntingdon county, Pa.

On June 19, 1907 he was united in marriage to Lilly May Flack at Pitcairn, Pa. For many years Mr. Bard was a successful salesman for the well known Heberling Products and canvassed Fulton county. He was a member of the Brethren church of Ligonier, Pa.
