

Ross E. Barkman

Ross Edward Barkman, 76, of Hustontown, died unexpectedly on Monday, November 29, 1971, at 12:30 P. M., at the Fulton County Medical Center.

Born in Bedford County on February 15, 1895, he was a son of the late Martin A. and Frances (Sponsler) Barkman. He was united in marriage with Hazel Reeder on April 18, 1918.

His wife survives, along with the following children: Mrs. Evelyn L. Laidig, of Johnstown; Mrs. Betty J. Luther, of Mentor, Ohio; Jack R. Barkman, of Sax-onburg, and Larry R. Barkman, of Cleburne, Texas. There are 15 grandchildren and five great grandchildren. One son preceeded him in death.
