

Nelle M. Barmont

Nelle M. Barmont passed away at her home in McConnellsburg on February 17, 1958. She had been in failing health the past year or more but death came most unexpectedly.

Born on January 4, 1888, near McConnellsburg, she was the daughter of the late Henry and Mary Roettger Barmont.

During her early life she taught school for several terms. In 1922, she graduated from the Chambersburg Hospital School of Nursing, later taking a post graduate course in obstetrics at a hospital in Cleveland, Ohio.

As long as her health permitted, she did private duty nursing and was always interested in establishing better health facilities for her community. She was one of a group of local citizens who planned and helped establish the Fulton County Medical Center and was a charter member of the auxiliary.

She was a member of the United Church of Christ in McConnellsburg.

Surviving are two brothers, W. Rush and C. Earl, both of McConnellsburg, Star Route. Two brothers and two sisters preceded her in death. Also surviving are eleven nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were held at 2:00 P. M. on Thursday from the Kelso Funeral Home, the Rev. Ernest W. Brindle officiating. Burial was made in the Union Cemetery.
