

**MRS. IDA M. BARNETT**

Our community was shocked and saddened Monday morning, June 2, 1947, when Ida May Barnett of Hustontown, Pa., passed to her eternal reward.

She had been in failing health since the death of her husband, seven years ago, but was not bedfast until May 11th (Mother's Day). Everything that loving hands could do for her was done willingly. She fell on the snow in January and since then had been doctoring continuously.

She was admitted to the Chambersburg Hospital, Tuesday eve, May 27, and died that at 8:30 A. M. (DST). June 2nd, from the affects of the grippe.

She was a daughter of the late Lewis and Malinda (Vallance) Shaw and was born at Hustontown, Pa., February 7, 1878. Mrs. Barnett was married to Joseph C. Barnett, April 25, 1912 at McConnellsburg by Rev. J. O. Royer of the Methodist church. Hence at the time of her death was aged 69 years, 3 months and 25 days. She cared for her husband so tenderly and patiently until his death in 1940. To this union two daughters were born, namely: Ruth, Mrs. Fred Hoffman at home, and Althea, Mrs. Edgar Hoffman of Three Springs, R. D. She also reared two step-children from the time they were quite young, Zelola, Mrs. Earl King of Waterfall and Clarence Barnett of Hustontown. Five brothers and one sister are deceased, namely: Z. Allison who died in 1905; Beatrice H. died in 1925; William H. Died in 1937; C. Floyd died in 1944; Georgianna died in 1945; John B. died May 22, 1947, just ten days before Mrs. Barnett. One brother, Nevin A. Shaw of Tyrona, survives.
