Bernard Palmer Barnhart, 82, Needmore, PA, died Saturday, February 17, 2001 at his home.

Born July 15, 1918 in Fulton County he was the son of the late Alonzo and Laura Sigel Barnhart.

He was a retired dairy farmer in Fulton County, where he had served on various Agriculture Boards for many years.

He was a member of the Warfordsburg Presbyterian Church, where he was Sunday School superintendent, deacon, elder and trustee.

He was a 1937 graduate of Warfordsburg High School and served as a director on the Southern Fulton School Board.

He was a charter member of the Needmore Grange and was a Fulton County Commissioner from 1955-1959.

He was honored in 1993 by the Fulton County Republican Party for leadership and dedicated service. He and his wife had 50 years of combined service to the Republican Party.

He is survived by his wife of 62 years, Margaret B. Duvall Barnhart of Needmore; three daughters: Linda Covalt, Hampstead, MD; Laura Muselman and Lois Deneen, both of Needmore; a son, Lowell Barnhart, Needmore; two sisters: Madeline Hendershot of Clear Spring, MD and Stella Hendershot of Warfordsburg; five grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two sisters: Geneva Bishop and Ruth Heller; two brothers: Glen Barnhart and Fred Barnhart.

Services were held Wednesday, February 21 at 11:00 a.m. at the Warfordsburg Presbyterian Church. Rev. John Barlow officiated. Burial was made in the Oakley Cemetery, Needmore.
