

Mrs. Lewis Barnhart

Mrs. Elizabeth Pearl Barnhart, 89, formerly of RD 1, McConnellsburg, died Tuesday, July 13, 1976, in Guilford Convalesarium where she had been a guest for four years. She had been ill for two weeks.

Mrs. Barnhart was born April 19, 1887, in Harrisonville, daughter of the late William H. and Mary Ann Fohner Fagley. She was a member of Sideling Hill Christian Church. Her first husband, Joseph J. Strait, died April 21, 1921. Her second husband, Lewis Barnhart, died January 12, 1970.
