

R. Blaine Bergstresser

Robert Blaine Bergstresser of Waterfall, died early Wednesday morning, July 10, 1963, at the Fulton Co. Medical Center. Mr. Bergstresser 81 years of age had been in failing health for 6 months.

The deceased was born at Waterfall on January 27, 1882, a son of Daniel and Margaret Baker Bergstresser. He was united in marriage on April 26, 1905, to Nora Gracey of Taylor township.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by these children: Merrill Bergstresser, of Hershey, Lamont Bergstresser of McConnellsburg, Mrs. Bruce Sheats, of Biglerville, Mrs. Leon Newman of Pittsburgh and Mrs. Max Madden of Shippensburg.
