Abner Bishop was born May 11, 1855, departed this life on March 28, 1929, aged 73 years, ten months and seventeen days. He lived in Bethel township near Deneen's Gap. He moved from West Virginia in 1910 and resided ever since on the farm where he died. Mr. Bishop was married to Matilda Goodman on December 18, 1876. To this union two children were born. One died in infancy. One daughter Laverna, at home, and his widow survive. The latter has been an invalid for almost three years. Mr. Bishop was an industrious man. He was a good neighbor, an honest, upright citizen. He was a regular attendant at church when health permitted. He will be greatly missed in the community. Funeral services were conducted at May's Chapel Christian church Saturday, March 30, by Rev. G. B. Sampson of Hancock, Md., who preached a very able sermon. Interment was made in the cemetery near the church.
