

BISHOP.

William Bishop, a one time resident of this place, died on Saturday, April 17, 1909, at the residence of Clarence Gobin, near Flintstone, Md., at the advanced age of eighty-two years. His funeral was held on Monday following his death. Interment was made at Tonoloway Baptist church in Thompson township.

Mr. Bishop lived for years in Thompson township. Some years ago he purchased property and moved to this place where he lived till the death of his wife. Having no children, life for him after the loss of his companion became lonely, and he sold his property and went to make his home with Mr. Gobin in Maryland.

He was a Mexican War veteran as well as a Civil War veteran. He was probably Fulton county's last Mexican War survivor.

He was reserved, but with his intimates he could, and did on occasion, throw off reserve, and then a recital of his war experiences was fascinating.

He was an honored member of the old school Baptist church having been reared in its faith, adhering to it through a long life.
