

Mrs. Nettie Bivens

Mrs. Nettie Lynch Bivens, of McConnellsburg, died on Wednesday morning, May 19 at 4 o'clock at the Fulton Co. Medical Center. She had been in ill health for a number of years but became critically ill on Tuesday morning. Death was attributed to a cerebral embolism.

Mrs. Bivens was born Nov. 23, 1881, in Ayr Township, Fulton county, the daughter of the late David and Margaret Gordon Lynch. She was the last survivor of her family.

In 1903 she was united in marriage to William E. Bivens, who preceded her in death, Nov. 21, 1931.

She was a member of the St. Paul's Reformed church, of McConnellsburg for many years.

Survivors include two daughters, Mrs. Albert Troxler, 632 E. Washington St., Chambersburg, and Mrs. Warren Daniels of McConnellsburg, five grandchildren and three great grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Friday afternoon at the Gress funeral home in McConnellsburg, at 2 o'clock conducted by her pastor the Rev. Ernest Brindle. Burial was made in the Union cemetery.
