John Carbaugh, a highly respected citizen of Ayr township, died Saturday Oct. 14th, 1916, aged 55 years 2 months and 23 days.

The deceased had been in ill health for more than year and confined to his bed for several months. The cause of his death was cancer of the stomach.

Mr. Carbaugh spent his entire life in Ayr township, was a hard worker and a faithful employee to his employers during the earlier part of his life. Later he engaged in tilling the soil for himself, which he followed until about a year ago when he retired on account of his health.
