CARPENTER.

At the age of seventy-seven years, Mr. Gilbert Carpenter died March 19, 1911, at his home one mile south of the Tonoloway Baptist church. He was first sick of grippe, and a general breakdown soon followed, which after nine weeks of patient suffering, ended in his death. He was a soldier in the Civil War, serving three years as a volunteer in an Illinois regiment.

Mr. Carpenter was a member of the Free Methodist church of Chicago, Ill., and had been a faithful member from the organization of that church.

He is survived by his wife who was Miss Ellen Weaver, and by six grand children and four great grand children, his sons and daughters having preceeded him to the grave years ago. His remains were laid to rest Tuesday afternoon in the cemetery at Tonoloway Baptist church, Rev. Thomas B. Arnold, of Wheaton, Ill., officiating.
