

## **John O. Chamberlain**

John Oliver Chamberlain 60, of Wells Valley, died at 4:30 Tuesday morning at the Fulton County Medical Center, McConnellsburg, following an illness of 3 and one-half years.

Born on Oct. 1, 1903, at Breezewood, he was a son of the late James H. and Margaretta Weisel Chamberlain. A member of Wells Valley E. U. B. Church, he had been employed as a coal miner and for the last 8 years worked as a crop reporter in Fulton county. He was an institutional representative of the Wells Valley Boy Scouts. He spent his entire life in Wells Valley.
