

Lewis Harris

Lewis Harris, 87, of South Second Street, McConnellsburg, died on Friday afternoon, September 13, 1968, at the Fulton County Medical Center, after a brief illness.

Born at Big Cove Tannery on August 9, 1881, he was a son of the late John and Martha Gordon Harris. He was a member of the Presbyterian Church of McConnellsburg; Mt. Zion Lodge F&AM, No. 774, and of the Harrisburg Consistory.

Mr. Harris had served on the board of directors of the First National Bank of McConnellsburg for 30 years, and had recently been named a director emeritus. He served as Fulton County's representative in the General Assembly for three terms, 1941-1942, 1943-1944 and 1951-1952, and had taught in the county schools for 26 terms. He was part owner of the Racket Store until 1958.

Surviving, in addition to his widow, Mrs. Zoe Mellott Harris, are two sons, Donald Harris, of Long Island, N. Y., and Ernest Harris, of Mercersburg. There are three grandchildren and four great grandchildren.

Funeral services were held on Monday, September 16, at 2:00 P. M., from the Kelso Funeral Home, the Rev. Robert Dent officiating. Interment was made in the Union Cemetery.
