

Waterfall Boy Killed by Tractor

A five-year-old Waterfall boy was instantly killed at his farm home on Friday evening when he was run over by a farm tractor which was being operated by his brother.

The accident victim was Donald Leroy King, son of Mr. and Mrs. James K. King of Waterfall.

Dr. R. C. McLucas of McConnellsburg, Fulton county coroner, was called to investigate the fatality. He decided that the lad's death was purely accidental.

The youngster was fatally injured when he jumped from the tractor and fell under the wheel of the machine. The accident happened at 7:00 o'clock Friday evening.

The deceased was born at Waterfall on July 1, 1953, a son of James K. King and Beulah (Roher) King.

In addition to his parents, he is survived by seven brothers and sisters: Mrs. Martha Neuder of Baltimore and Beulah, James, Robert, Alice, George and Zola, all at home.

Funeral services were held on Monday afternoon at 2:00 o'clock at the House Funeral Chapel at Hustontown. The Rev. Thomas Bambling of Langdondale officiated and interment was made in the Fairview Cemetery.
