

Lockard, Ella E.

Mrs. Ella Lockard, widow of John Lockard, died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. J. E. Anderson of Kearney, on Wednesday morning, March 17, 1937, at 7:30 o'clock. Death was due to a complication of diseases.

Mrs. Lockard was born at Wells Valley, Fulton county on February 10, 1865, a daughter of Washington and Elsie (Woodcock) Edwards, both deceased. She was aged 72 years, 1 month and 8 days. She was a member of the Methodist church at Wells Valley. In 1896 she was united in marriage to John Lockard who preceded her in death a number of years ago.

Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. J. E. Anderson of Kearney, one sister, Mrs. Clara Ann Miller of Six Mile Run, and one brother, Amon G. Edwards of Wells Tannery.

Funeral services were held at the Church of the Brethren in Wells Valley on Saturday afternoon, March 20, 1937, at 2:00 o'clock, with the Rev. W. W. Breckbill officiating. Interment was made in the Brethren cemetery.
