**Alfred C. McCoy**

Alfred C. McCoy of Fort Littleton died of heart disease at the Fulton County Medical Center at 8:45 A. M. on March 21, 1960, after a long illness.

A son of the late John William and Lillie Buck McCoy, he was born at Madisonville on September 19, 1891. He was united in marriage with Zeldie Mae Johnson on October 25, 1923.
