Elmer K. "Bub" Melius, 67, 208 Butternut Lane, Chambersburg, died the morning of July 14, 1980, in the Chambersburg Hospital of a massive stroke.

Born June 14, 1913, in Hustontown, he was the son of the late Philip and Sarah Kellner Melius.

Mr. Melius was a retired employee of the Stanley Co. and drove a bus to Stanley and to Letterkenny Army Depot from Fulton County for 22 years.
