

JOHN A. PITTMAN

John A. Pittman, 51, Warfordsburg, was dead on arrival at Fulton County Medical Center Wednesday morning. Death was attributed to a heart attack.

Mr. Pittman was born Aug. 14, 1923, in McConnellsburg, son of the late McClellan and Mame Gillis Pittman. He was a veteran of World War II and was Fulton County's only blacksmith. He was of the Protestant faith.

Surviving are two daughters: Candace J., Washington, D.C., and Mrs. Cheryl Katoc, Glendale, Ariz.; three brothers and a sister: Mathew, Paul and Robert Pittman, Mrs. Mary Kline, all of McConnellsburg, and three grandchildren.

Funeral service will be at 2 p.m. Saturday in the Pittman home in Warfordsburg, with the Rev. Dr. David R. Hoover officiating. Burial will be in Presbyterian Cemetery, Warfordsburg. *Feb 26-75*
