

Nicholas H. Roettger

Nicholas Henry Roettger, died at his late home in McConnellsburg on Tuesday, January 6, 1953, after a lingering illness, at the age of 86 years and 6 days.

He was born Dec. 31, 1866 in Todd township, Fulton Co. the son of Christian and Philipena Roettger, being the last survivor of a family of eight children.

He was married Dec. 7, 1887, to Eva Netta Lehman, who preceded him in death five years ago.

He is survived by two daughters, Ruth and Naomi, both at home, and by a number of nieces and nephews.

Nick, as he was familiarly known, followed the plumbing and heating trade for a number of years, having helped to install the water plant in McConnellsburg, some 50 years ago.

He was a member of Saint Paul's Lutheran church of McConnellsburg.

Funeral services were held on Saturday, Jan. 10, 1953, from the Kelso funeral home with his pastor, Rev. David R. Hoover and Rev. Ernest Brindle officiating. Burial was made in the Cove Union cemetery.
