

## Donald M. Shaw

Donald Merrill Shaw, 44, of R R Waterfall, Fulton Co. died unexpectedly of a heart condition on Wednesday in Framingham, Mass. He had been in ill health for the past two years.

Mr. Shaw was born at New Grenada, and was a son of the late William and Viola Sipes Shaw. He was of the Protestant faith.

Mr. Shaw was formerly employed as a miner by the Orbisonia and Rock Hill Coal Co., and at the time of his death was a steelworker.
