WILLIAM A. YOUSE

William A. Youse died at his home near McConnellsburg, Sunday, Aug. 4, 1935 after an illness of about five days. He was a son of James and Sarah Youse and was born near McConnellsburg July 1, 1878, being aged 57 years, one month and 3 days.

Mr. Youse was a quiet unassuming citizen, bearing his affliction of the past twenty years or more with patience and fortitude.
